COVID-19 Precautions Advisory

For Students Visiting the Campus for Graduation Activities

As we continue to see the development and spread of new variants of the COVID-19 virus, it is important to be reminded of a few precautions to not just safeguard ourselves but also those around us. It is therefore necessary to ensure that persons who may suspect they could be sick take precautions to not come into contact with others and to get tested immediately so that you will know your status and be better able to take precautions and also to get care.

Symptoms Check:

- 1. Are you experiencing any of the following symptoms?
 - a. Dry cough
 - b. Runny nose
 - c. Body or muscle aches
 - d. Fever
 - e. Lost of taste or smell
 - f. Severe and persistent headaches
 - g. Vomiting (not linked to bad food, other medications or pregnancy)
 - h. Any other flu like symptoms
- 2. Have you been in recent physical contact with anyone suspected and/or confirmed of having COVID-19?
- 3. Have you been in recent physical contact with anyone (whether in public or household) that has flu like symptoms as mentioned above?

If <u>yes</u> to any of the above questions, please stay at home and get tested. If you get a positive test you MUST stay at home and use the instructions given for you to take your photo yourself and submit it online to: <u>graduation.decc@uog.edu.gy</u>

<u>Please note:</u> If you have recently taken a Covid-19 test and you are awaiting your result, kindly **stay home** until you have received your result.

All persons coming unto campus at any time for any reason, kindly remember to utilize the sanitizing tunnels upon entry into the campus.

You must stop with security, present your status document, take your temperature, present your graduation letter and ID card to the security, BEFORE proceeding to collect your gowns and take your photos.

Please keep your mask on and sanitize at all times.

Also, please note that every time you leave the campus and enter again you are required to use the sanitizing tunnel each time.
